### Course Content/Syllabus

- Build on the knowledge, understanding and skills for GCSE, but also accommodate the needs of students who have an appropriate level of the language but have not studied for GCSE.
- Integrate, where appropriate, the skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing in the development of linguistic competence.
- Provide a coherent satisfying and worthwhile course of study for students who do not progress to further study in the subject.
- There are 3 units:-
- Unit 1 – listening and writing – retrieving and conveying information on the basis of recorded target language material (responses mainly in the target language).
- Unit 2 – Reading and Writing – retrieving and conveying information on the basis of printed target language material (responses mainly in the target language, including continuous writing).

Unit 3 – prepared oral topic – Prepared topic (opinions, information on culture or society of the target language)
