Course Content/Syllabus

The syllabus will be a revision and extension of Level 1 topics: see PRIOR EXPERIENCE. The ability to use the past and simple future tenses will be developed during this year. Learners will continue to focus on the four key skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing. The course will also include:

Accommodation including enquiring, using the telephone, filling in forms, understanding details from signs etc. advance bookings, coping with problems/complaints and paying the bill.

Eating out including getting a table and choosing a meal.

Shopping including buying souvenirs and presents.

Using Public transport including asking the way to the bus, train and their availability, buying tickets, recognising signs, hiring a car, breakdown, loss and theft.

Leisure and business including giving and receiving invitations, arranging meetings and finding out about leisure opportunities, weather.

Talking about yourself including what you do, past/future intentions and past actions, illness.
