### Course Content/Syllabus

- Build on the knowledge, understanding and skills for GCSE, but also accommodate the needs of students who have an appropriate level of the language but have not studied for GCSE.
- Integrate, where appropriate, the skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing in the development of linguistic competence.
- Provide a coherent satisfying and worthwhile course of study for students who do not progress to further study in the subject.
- There are 2 units which draw upon 4 general topic areas:
  - Youth culture & Concerns**
  - Lifestyle: Health & Fitness**
  - The World Around us:** travel, tourism, environmental issues and the Target Language world
  - Education & Employment**
- Unit 1 – Spoken Expression and Response in the Target Language -**  
Students respond to Edexcel set questions on a stimulus related to chosen general topic area.  
Students engage in a discussion relating to general topic area and other areas.
- Unit 2 – Understanding and Written response in the Target Language –**  
Students will listen to a range of authentic target language material, to retrieve and convey information, by responding to a range of target language questions.  
Students will read authentic target language materials, retrieving & conveying information by responding to a range of test types.  
Students will be required to write 200+ words in the form of a letter/report/article in the target language, based on a short target language stimulus.

### Assessment Methods

This course leads to a Spanish A/S level qualification

### Home Study

Home study is essential in order to achieve.

### Attendance

**Regular attendance is required.** All students enrolling on this course must take the accreditation

### Entry Requirements

To have completed a course equivalent of GCSE to at least Grade A or to have lived in a Spanish speaking country

Ability to research and write essays
