Course Content/Syllabus

LEVEL 1: The focus of the teaching is an effective communication and building a good foundation for future learning. The course will concentrate on Listening and Speaking. This course will include the following:

Get to know people

Covering introduction, greeting, courtesies, apologies, exchanging personal information including family, pets and where you live.

Get about

Including identifying signs and notices, asking the way, understanding directions.

Get something to eat and drink

Including making choices, expressing likes and dislikes, paying the bill, going shopping, buying food, getting the right quantity, buying petrol, souvenirs.

Obtain services

Including changing money, getting stamps and visiting the garage, getting information in a tourist office and asking about opening times; Book into a hotel, including getting the room you want, asking about facilities, dealing with complaints
