Course Content/Syllabus

The focus of the teaching on this taster course is on effective communication and building a good foundation for future learning. The course will concentrate mainly on Speaking & Listening. This course will include the following:

Getting to know people

Covering introduction, greeting, courtesies, apologies, exchanging personal information including family, pets and where you live.

Getting about

Including asking the way, understanding directions.

Getting something to eat and drink

Including making choices, expressing likes and dislikes, ordering in a café/restaurant

Obtaining services

Including booking a hotel room and obtaining tourist information; shopping.

Talking about hobbies and free time, including what you usually do and when, what you prefer to do, your feelings and opinions.

After completing the course, students should be able to:

- Use/Understand basic words/key phrases in familiar situations in the target language.
- Ask simple questions.
- Understand/use simple phrases to exchange information.
- Recognise / understand basic written signs & texts on familiar subjects in the target language.
- Write basic short phrases in the target language.
