Course Content/Syllabus

As per Scola Modern Foreign Languages Leaflet

The course will include the following:

Discussion on:

- Self and others
- Students' own topics including sport, travel, cinema, theatre, entertainment, food, health
- Shopping enquiries, places and objects
- Resolution of practical problems
- Phone conversations
- Feelings and tastes

After completing the course, students should be able to:

- Be comfortable with a range of tenses and be able to listen and read authentic texts on familiar matters
- Be able to maintain a conversation and write on familiar matters and predictable situations using a range of simple language
- Express themselves in different ways using the target language only

Assessment Methods

There will be 4 informal assessments during the course of the year for Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing, based on material covered during the year. This material will cover the Can-do statements for Intermediate Stage. These assessments will be conducted by the tutor.

Home Study

One hour a week is expected for homework and research tasks.
