Course Content/Syllabus

Who is the course for?

This is the first of a two-year level 4/5 qualification to teach in the post-16 sector. Students on this course are required to propose a qualified subject specialist who is willing to act as their mentor.

The course will cover the PTLLS & CTLLS syllabus which includes:

- The role & responsibilities of a teacher
- Micro-teaching
- Teaching & learning approaches and resources
- Barriers to learning & support
- All aspects of assessment & record keeping
- Planning & communication
- Theories of learning
- Emerging technologies in the classroom
- Embedding skills for life
- Development of CPD & networking
- Being a reflective practitioner

Assessment Methods

The course is accredited by Canterbury Christ Church University. It will be assessed through the completion of assignments, reflective essays and observed teaching sessions which are presented in portfolios for marking.

Home Study

Home study is essential in order to achieve – this will include reading, research & writing essays.

Attendance

Regular attendance is required. **All students enrolling on this course must take the accreditation.**

Entry Requirements

Students wishing to enrol on this course are required to have access to a minimum of 75 hours of teaching groups of post-16 learners. Applicants should have a level 3 vocational or professional qualification, good English skills (A level standard) and will also need (or agree to undertake) level 2 qualifications in English, maths & ICT.

English, Maths & IT Entry Requirements

English skills suitable for writing academically at degree level, and the ability to read and research extensively. At least Level 2 (GCSE Level) in English, Maths and IT or the ability to gain qualifications at this level.
