Course Content/Syllabus

This course will continue in September in the next academic year 2011/2012

Applicants for this course must have passed BSL level 1 and have maintained, through regular practice, their signing to at least BSL level 1 examination standard.

There are 3 units:

- Receptive signs
- Productive signs
- Dialogue and conversation skills.

After completing the course, students should be able to:

- Participate in a conversation using sign language without misunderstanding
- Demonstrate and respond to an appropriate selection vocabulary, amount and range
- Understand and produce a signed narrative without omissions or inaccuracies

Assessment Methods

Videod assessment of 3 units at the end of the course.

Home Study

Home study is essential in order to achieve. Learners are required to complete 50 plus hours to achieve the credit points required for the certification. This includes research, meeting deaf people, practising signing at home, watching signed DVDs and signed TV programmes etc.
