### Course Content/Syllabus

This is an intensive, exciting course to introduce students to different art & craft disciplines including 2D fine art painting & drawing, mixed media, printmaking, graphic design, photography, creative digital media & 3D design including ceramics and jewellery.

The emphasis of the course will be on developing core skills; experimentation and personal response; improving research skills; the importance of reflective journals and sketchbooks; contextual studies looking at the work of traditional and contemporary artists.

The course is in three sections: Stage 1 - exploratory, Stage 2 - pathway and Stage 3 - confirmatory. Stage 3 consists of a Final Major Project in a chosen pathway. There is the opportunity to achieve pass, merit or distinction in this final phase.

Students will produce a portfolio of work and a final exhibition of their Final Major Project.

### Assessment Methods

Stage 1 (exploratory) & Stage 2 (pathway) are assessed by your tutors and internally moderated and verified. Stage 3 (confirmatory)- Final Major Project is internally moderated and externally verified by EDEXCEL.
