This course will follow the Early Learning and Childcare Pathway and will include the following topics:

- Understanding and promoting child and young person development
- Understanding how to safeguard the well being of children and young people
- Promoting learning and development in the early years
- Professional practice in early years settings
- Supporting children's speech, language and communication

After completing the course, students should be able to:

- Work as a competent supervisor in a pre-school or Early Years setting.
- Meet children's individual learning needs.
- Outline the responsibilities for supporting children's social and emotional development, their well-being and safety.
- Promote positive partnerships between parents, carers and the pre-school.
- Offer cohesive and effective support to families seeking pre-school care and education for their children.

Assessment Methods

Learners must meet all knowledge and performance criteria through assignments, reflections, written records and observations

Entry Requirements

Must be able to write assignments. Must be working in pre-school or Early Years setting or have regular access to workplace practice for assessment at least 2 days a week.
