Course Content/Syllabus

This course will cover Law Making, the Legal System and the Concept of Liability and will include the following topics:

- Domestic legislative process
- Judicial precedent
- Statutory interpretation
- Court structure – civil and criminal
- Legal profession and judges
- Juries
- Magistrates
- Introduction to criminal liability
- Introduction to Tort

After completing the course, students should be able to:

- Understand the above topics
- Write essays
- Solve problems
- Critically discuss legal issues
- Evaluate and apply legal rules
- Analyse legal material

Assessment Methods

Written examination at the end of the course. This course leads to a GCE A/S level in Law. There will be two 1 ½ hour exams over 2 different days in May and June (with an option of taking selected subjects in January)

The first exam covers Units 1A and 1B, worth 50% of the marks.

The second exam covers Units 2A which is compulsory and choice of Units 2B or 2C, worth 50% of the marks.

Home Study

Home study is essential in order to achieve – reading, research & writing essays.

Attendance

Regular attendance is required. **All students enrolling on this course must take the accreditation.**

Entry Requirements

Good literacy skills. A GCSE standard of education is preferred.

English, Maths & IT Entry Requirements

Good literacy skills and the ability to research & write essays. IT skills an advantage.
