### Course Content/Syllabus

Learners must work or be a regular volunteer in a pre-school or other appropriate practical placement, 200 hours is required over the duration of the course for those with no previous experience, as students need to show competence in knowledge and skills. Help can be given to find a voluntary placement.

### Course Content

- Will cover a diverse range of job roles and occupational areas working in children's workforce setting including early years and social care
- Covers the age range from birth to 19 years
- Is made up of a mandatory and optional units which are based on a knowledge and skills

Plus an optional unit selected by the tutor.

### Assessment Methods

Learners must meet all knowledge and performance criteria through assignments, reflection, written records and observation

### Home Study

Home study is essential in order to achieve – research & writing essays.

### Attendance

Regular attendance is required. **All students enrolling on this course must take the accreditation.**

### Entry Requirements

This is a qualification for those working as assistants in pre-school or early years settings.

### English, Maths & IT Entry Requirements

Good literacy skills and the ability to research & write essays. IT skills an advantage but not essential.
