Course Content/Syllabus

This course will include the following topics:

- Social situations and giving information
- Describing
- Asking for, giving & justifying opinions
- Following/giving instructions
- Asking for things
- Expressing ability
- Using numbers and expressing time
- Agreeing/disagreeing
- Comparing and expressing preferences
- Making & responding to suggestions
- Expressing feelings and emotions
- Using present, future and past tenses
- Talking about im(probability) and (im)possibility
- Giving advice and warnings
- Taking turns in conversation

After completing, students will have the choice which elements of listening, speaking, reading and writing they wish to be assessed in and the possibility of undertaking mid-year ASSET assessment.

- Use a range of tenses and use and adapt language for new purposes. Spelling and pronunciation should be accurate, and you should be able to write on familiar matters, maintain a conversation, follow and summarise what you hear, and give an oral/written summary or translation of what you have read.

Assessment Methods

Continuous classroom assessments based on 'Can Do' statements. End of year test on some or all of the four skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing
